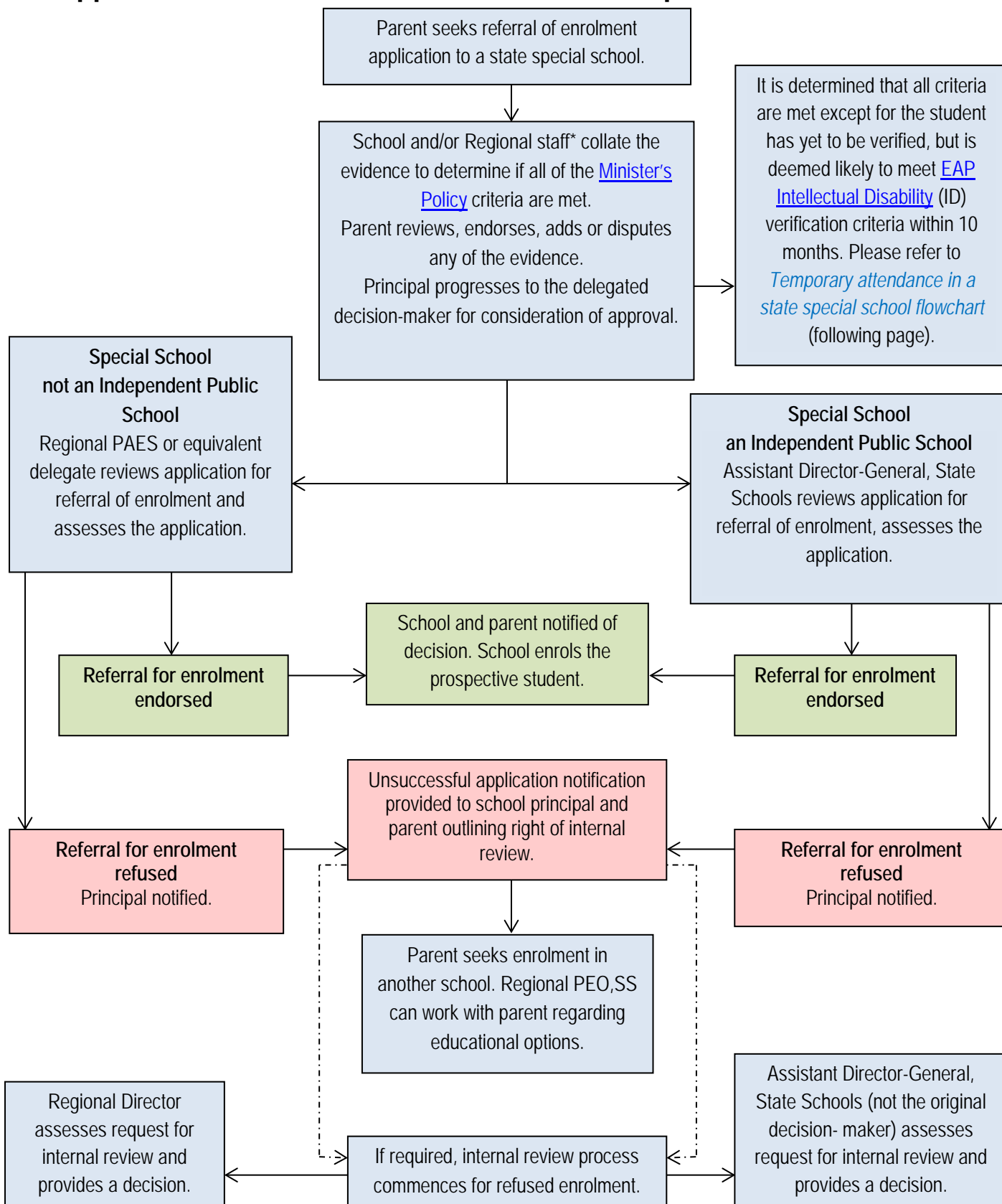


Application for referral of enrolment to a state special school flowchart

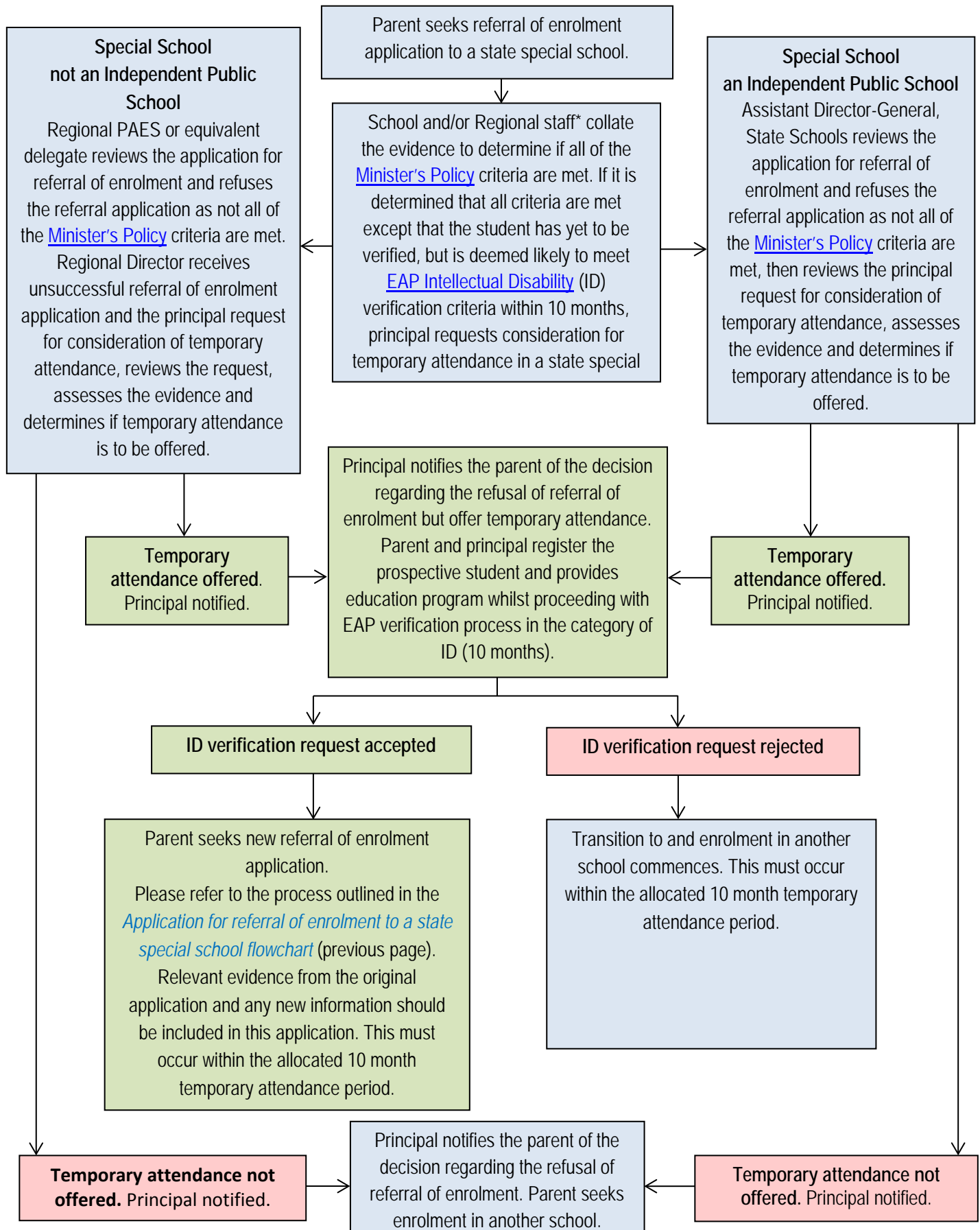


In accordance with ss.166 and 167 of the *Education (General Provisions) Act 2006* (EGPA), the Chief Executive of the Department of Education and Training is responsible for determining whether a student does or does not satisfy the requirements of referral for enrolment in a special school.

* All queries received by a region regarding enrolment in a special school that is an Independent Public School, need to be forwarded to that school for review and action.

Important note: Whether temporary attendance is offered or not, the decision-maker has refused enrolment and therefore parents have a **right to internal review of the enrolment decision** as outlined on [Application for referral of enrolment to a state special school flowchart](#) (previous page). There is no appeal against temporary attendance not being offered.
