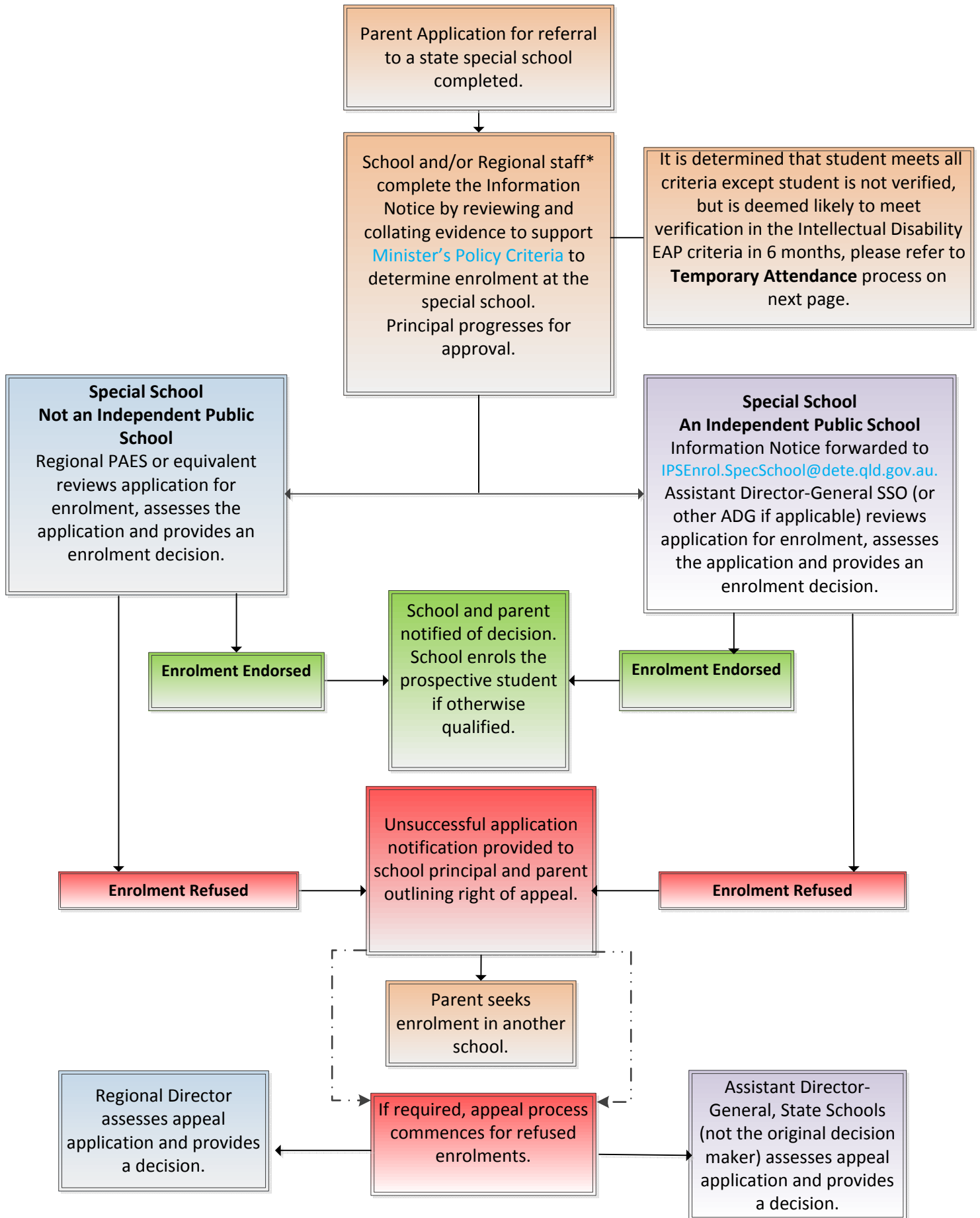


# Application for Enrolment in a Queensland State Special School

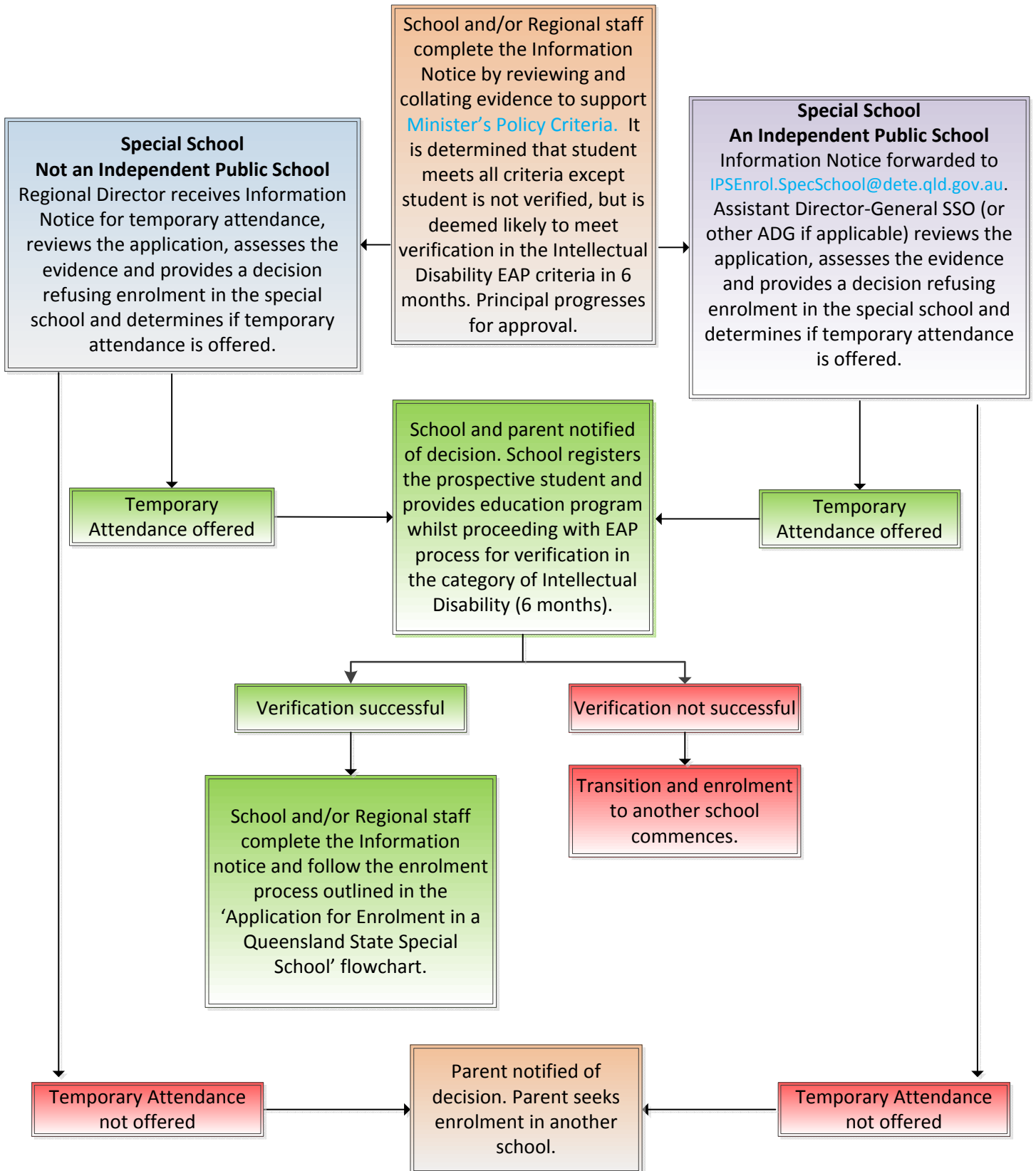


In accordance with Sections 166 and 167 of the *Education (General Provisions) Act 2006* (EGPA), the Chief Executive of the Department of Education and Training is responsible for determining whether a student does or does not satisfy the requirements of referral for enrolment in a special school.

\* All queries received by a region regarding enrolment in a special school that is an independent public school, need to be forwarded to this school for review and action.

# Temporary Attendance in a Queensland State Special School



Important to note that whether temporary attendance is offered or not, the decision maker has refused enrolment and therefore parents have a **right to appeal the enrolment decision** as outlined on Application for Enrolment in a State Special School on previous page. There is no appeal against temporary attendance not being offered.
